Mr. Crumbaker presented Resolution 2023-07, known as the Delegation Resolution; it accomplishes the following:

- Authorizes the issuance of the Series 2023 Bonds and a not-to-exceed amount of \$7.5 million to finance the Assessment Area One Project.
- Delegates authority to the Board Chair, Vice Chair and District Staff to undertake certain actions with regard to the marketing and sale of the Series 2023 Bonds.
- Approves the form of First Supplemental Indentures and incorporates specific terms with respect to the bonds being issued in 2023.
- Authorizes the negotiated sale of the Series 2023 Bonds by the Underwriter, with certain limitations.
- Approves the Bond Purchase Contract.
- Approves certain parameters that, if not exceeded, the District Chair is authorized to proceed with the execution of the Bond Purchase Contract.
- Approves the form of Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum and the Continuing Disclosure Agreement.
